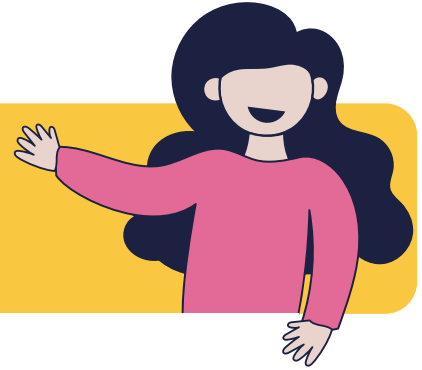


School to-do list.

All students should watch the lesson in the same place.

If you REALLY want your whole school to take part and CANNOT fit them in one place, please email me at recordbreak@lauramucha.com by 1st October - it's complicated but it may be possible.

To-do list for class teacher:



1. Ask students to use the loo BEFORE the lesson (if they go to the loo during, they cannot count towards the record break).
2. Get students into the place they will be watching the lesson for 10am. If they are not there by 10:15am, they will not be counted.
3. **Before / during the lesson, please:**
 - a. use a register to count students as they enter one by one, and film this happening for 30 seconds
 - b. take a photo of students from the back (I'll ask you to-do this shortly after 10:15am)
 - c. film the entire space (including entrance and exits) and the back of students' heads watching the lesson for 30 seconds. (I'll ask you to-do this shortly after 10:15am).
4. **After the lesson:**
 - a. each class teacher must fill out [this brief online form](#) for 'stewards' (to confirm how many students in their class took part).
 - b. each school must upload the 30 second video of students being counted as they come in, and the photo and 30 second video of them taking part (any class teacher, head or deputy headteacher can do this [here](#)).

To-do list for headteacher / deputy / assistant:



1. The headteacher / deputy head / assistant **must watch the whole lesson**, including students being counted into wherever they will be for the lesson.
2. **After the lesson**, they must complete [this short online form](#) for 'witnesses' (to confirm how many from the school took part - and that GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS™ guidelines were followed).
3. If class teachers have not uploaded the video / photo evidence (detailed above), the headteacher / deputy head / assistant (or anyone at the school) can do this [here](#).

These are **GUINNESS WORLD RECORDS™** requirements, basically to show that we aren't making it all up!

Your school and students cannot be counted without them.
